TRIALS CHAMPIONSHIP RULES

- 1 POINTS WILL BE GIVEN TO RIDERS IN EACH GRADE AS FOLLOWS :-20-17-15-13-11-10-9-8-7-6-5-4-3-2-1
- 2 POINTS WILL **NOT** BE GIVEN UNLESS THERE ARE AT LEAST 3 RIDERS COMPETING IN THAT GRADE
- 3 POINTS WILL **NOT** BE GIVEN TO RIDERS WHO RIDE OUTSIDE THEIR NORMAL GRADE -- (UP or DOWN)
- 4 THE COMPETITION WILL INCLUDE ALL MC-I CHAMPIONSHIP TRIALS.
- 5 TIES WILL BE GIVEN IN FAVOUR OF THE COMPETITOR WHO HAS SCORED IN THE GREATEST NUMBER OF COUNTING EVENTS, IF THE TIE PERSISTS, TO THE RIDER WITH THE MOST WINS, 2nd's, 3rd's ETC. & IF TIE STILL CANNOT BE BROKEN THE TROPHY (OR PLACE) WILL BE SHARED OVER THE YEAR INVOLVED.
